


BYLAW NO. 2/95


A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES USING BRIDGES

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake No. 588 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In the bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "Motor Vehicles" shall have the same meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicle Weights and Dimension Regulations, 1988 (amended).
2. It shall be unlawful to drive any motor vehicle with a gross weight of more than 14 (fourteen) tonnes over the bridge (s) located East of the SE 3-59-17-W3rd.
3.
 - (a) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of any offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
 - (b) Pursuant to The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983 - 84, where such person is convicted, the convicting provincial magistrate or justice of the peace may, if the public improvement injured is a public highway or anything forming part of or used in connection with such highway, order the person to pay to the municipality the cost of repairing the injury, and if the person fails to comply with the order the cost of the repairing the injury may be recovered from the person or owner as a debt due to the municipality.
