

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MEADOW LAKE No 588

A ByLaw to designate the Property known as THE CABANA COMMUNITY HALL as being of Historical Value.

WHEREAS Part 111 of the Heritage Property Act, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake No 588 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as CABANA COMMUNITY HALL at MEADOW LAKE a Notice of Intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one(21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration;

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Secretary of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake No 588 enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of historical interest the real property known as the CABANA COMMUNITY HALL at MEADOW LAKE, Saskatchewan, and legally described as:

All that portion of the North East quarter of Section One (1), in Township Fifty-Nine (59), in Range Sixteen (16), West of the Third Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the west boundary where the roadway shown on Plan No 62-B-00691, intersects the Western boundary; thence southerly along the said west boundary five hundred and sixty-eight feet; (568); thence easterly perpendicular to the said west boundary one hundred and forty (140) feet; thence northerly and parallel to the said west boundary to the said roadway; thence westerly along the south boundary of the said roadway to the point of commencement.

The significance of the site is as follows:

Pioneer church built by the first settlers in the Cabana Community.

2. The Municipal Secretary is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.

3. The Secretary is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of Culture and Youth, and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
